

Yasmin Amber School of Dance Policies-

Terms & Conditions

1. Behaviour

- Every student/parent at Yasmin Amber School of Dance must respect their surroundings, other students/parents and teachers.
- Other people use the facilities at Woodhouse Eaves Village Hall, please behave appropriately and help us to build a fantastic reputation. Anyone breaching this on a regular basis may be asked to leave the school.
- Do not leave the studio without permission from a teacher.

2. Anti-bullying

- Bullying will not be accepted or condoned. All forms of bullying will be addressed. Yasmin Amber School of Dance will not tolerate bullying of any kind. Any parent who feels their child may be being bullied is encouraged to please notify the Principal. Upon being made aware of a bullying incidence, the Principal will liaise with the parent of the affected child and the parent of the child who is bullying.
- The Principal will consider removal of any child seen to be bullying another from the classes.

3. Class Attendance

- All students must arrive promptly to the scheduled class time, punctuality is of great importance due to examination and show practice in lessons.
- Students may be refused entry if they are continuously late for class as they are missing out on warming up safely for class.

4. Drop Off & Collection

- All students must be signed in and out of class by the teacher. Parents are to drop off and collect from the main door (unless told otherwise), the doors will be opened 5 minutes before the first class of the day starts or at the class start time for all classes following this.
- Children are to arrive in Tap shoes if taking a IDTA Tap, Ballet and Modern mixed session.
- If your child is being collected by someone else you must declare this on drop off so we are aware.

5. Absence

- Refunds will NOT be given to those who cannot attend class, including injuries. Please see our Payment Agreement for more details.

6. Injuries

- Students/parents or guardians should inform the teacher of any special health considerations or existing injuries before participating in class.

7. Single Dance School Enrolment

- Yasmin Amber School of Dance requires that students are NOT enrolled at another dance school whilst taking classes with us. This ensures students are NOT going to miss out on participating in examinations and our annual dance show or have a conflicting level of technique being taught. At the principal's discretion exceptions may be made.

8. Food

- No food is to be eaten whilst dancing and in class, snacks may be eaten between lessons if children are staying for 1.5 hours or more, however, all snacks must be appropriate and strictly must contain NO NUTS!
- No chewing gum!
- Water is permitted in non-spill capped bottles, no Stanleys.

9. Staff Disclosure & First Aid Training

- All teachers and administrators working at Yasmin Amber School of Dance are disclosure checked before commencing work. First aid training & safeguarding training is renewed regularly.
- If students require an epipen or similar this must be brought to every class so we have it in the case of an emergency.

10. Valuables

- Please leave all valuables at home, Yasmin Amber School Of Dance will NOT be liable for any loss or damage to personal items.

11. Jewellery

- No jewellery is to be worn in class including watches or ankle bracelets, this is for health and safety reasons.

12. Hair

- Hair must be tied back neatly for all classes as long hair down is unsafe! We will not be held responsible for student's hair being stood on or caught if not followed:

Ballet, Tap, Modern & Stage Class- Classical bun.

Musical Theatre, Street, Open Jazz- Slick pony tails may be worn.

Acro-Low bun

(Students with particularly short hair must wear a soft hair band to keep hair out of their eyes.)

13. Uniform

- Uniform must be observed at all times, after your 6th week at Yasmin Amber uniform is compulsory. Details of the uniform requirements for each group can be found on our website.

14. Dance Examinations

- Our dance examinations are taken with the IDTA (International Dance Teachers Association). If your child takes BTM classes they will be given this opportunity yearly, students who take Open Jazz, MT or Street Dance are given this opportunity every few years. Although it is not compulsory, students are encouraged to do so. Partly as a measure of progress and also a reward of all their hard work.
- Students are entered at the discretion of the principal, with compulsory extra examination practice shortly before the exam weekend.

15. Dance Show

- Our annual show is not compulsory, however, we encourage students to take part as it is lots of fun and the highlight of our school year.
- If your child is participating in our annual show we will need excellent attendance in the lead up to the show. Dance is a team sport so other students missing classes can really affect the rest of the group. ALL classes MUST be attended in the 6-week run up to the show. Please email or text Miss Yasmin if your child is unable to attend a session as they may need extra practice.
- Your child MUST be available for ALL show dates to be able to take part, this includes: any rehearsals and both the Saturday and Sunday shows.
